WASTE TO ART TEXTILE WORKSHOPS

Theme: Family and Love – Portraiture

Date: Monday 22 September
Age Group: 8 – 12 Years

Who am I? Learn traditional weaving skills and use these skills to create a self-portrait on recycled cardboard. Bring along an old piece of clothing or fabric to incorporate with the other recycled materials that will be provided, such as shopping bags, bottle caps, and old buttons. These materials will be cut up and woven into an image that represents you and who you are within your family.

Date: Tuesday 23 September
Age Group: 13 – 16 Years

Discover unconventional methods of creating a 'portrait' of someone close to you (hint: it DOESN'T have to be a face!). Work with recycled textiles/fabrics to produce a collaged artwork that has a personal meaning to you. We'll look at memory and how textiles and objects can remind us of people, places and events. Shred, rip, tear, cut, and scrunch away while making string, stitching and losing yourself in the creative process.

DRAWING & MIXED MEDIA WORKSHOPS

Theme: History and Culture – Architecture and Landscapes

Date: Monday 29 September
Age Group: 8 – 12 Years

Discover Rookwood's beautiful views of the Sydney CBD, including the historic Opera House and the Harbour Bridge. Explore these city views and create charcoal drawings that will be used to develop mixed media collages that tell stories about Sydney's history and culture. This workshop will explore a range of techniques that can be used to make a unique collage.

Date: Tuesday 30 September
Age Group: 13 – 16 Years

Have you ever wanted to learn how to reproduce images into a different scale? Working with old photographs, take an imaginary journey through time along the old railway line from Central Station to Rookwood Cemetery. After learning how to create a scaled up image of these historic photos, you can give your artwork a new twist by embellishing with colourful mediums, texture and collage.

WASTE TO ART SCULPTURE WORKSHOPS

Theme: Nature and Environment – Animal Life at Rookwood

Date: Wednesday 24 September
Age Group: 8 – 12 Years

Lots of animals live at or visit Rookwood. Create a sculpture inspired by the local fauna, including birds, rabbits, and dogs, by assembling recycled plastic items along with unique, hand-made, coloured pulp made from discarded office paper. You will also see a demonstration of the pulp making process, which includes pulping soaked paper with an electric drill, straining it to remove the water and mixing in the glue.

Date: Thursday 25 September
Age Group: 13 – 16 Years

Explore Rookwood's parkland environment and discover how to turn your waste into a feathered bird sculpture. After getting to know some of the native bird varieties found at Rookwood, you will learn how to cut, bend, mold and reproduce a variety of discarded materials into your own creative and colorful bird sculptures.

CARTOONING WORKSHOPS

Theme: Multiculturalism

Date: Wednesday 1 October
Age Group: 8 – 12 Years

Have you ever wanted to learn how to draw cartoons? Using circles explore your creativity and draw anything you can see and think of, this could focus on objects from around the globe. The workshop will allow you to explore your creativity and learn the basic foundations of cartooning that will leave you feeling like a pro.

Date: Thursday 2 October
Age Group: 13 – 16 Years

Cartooning is an International language. Working with the basic foundations of cartooning and reviewing old animation techniques you will learn how to draw manga. During this workshop you will explore multiculturalism by reviewing cartoons from around the world. Use your imagination to create manga cartoons of your own.
